- 1     **Q: ALL**    Is Southeast Louisiana Flood Protection Authority – East (SLFPAE) open to negotiate the terms and conditions at the contract stage with the awarded Proposer /Contractor?

**A:**        Negotiations will be held at time of event based off of event response required.
  
- 2     **Q:**        Appendix A – Insurance Requirements   Due to the scope of work defined that is related to Monitoring Disaster Debris Management services, is SLFPAE open to modifications to the insurances requirements that do apply?

**A:**        Any insurance modifications will be made based off of event response required.
  
- 3     **Q:**        Part 6-c - Subcontractor Plan 14. The RFQ infers that a subcontractor is required as part of our qualifications. However, if we self-perform the services, could we state that subcontractors will not be used and therefore we will not be required to provide a Subcontractor Plan with our qualifications?

**A:**        Subcontractors are not required. Provide a statement with your intent.

1. Q: Under 2.3 Scope of work Basic Services, Item C. Roving Debris Monitor Services, the RFP states " The monitoring contractor shall provide at least one monitor for each debris pickup zone as prescribed by the Authority" – How many pickup zones will there be?

A: To be determined based off of event response required.
  
2. Q: Will haulers be required to remove freon from refrigerators?

A: Debris removal contractor to work out disposal details of material with disposal sites.
  
3. Q: Under 2.5 Additional Services – can you provide some examples of possible additional services we would be expected to perform?

A: Any additional services will be determined based off of event response required and contracts negotiated at that point.
  
4. Q: Under 3.2 RFQ Requirements and format, Part 4 – Financial Stability of the Respondent, item c states "Letters from the bonding surety declaring the Respondents allowable limit for Performance Bonding. - is this for engineering consulting firms or contractors only?

A: Bonding not required for monitoring contractors. Required for removal contractors.
